ORDER

In the KAU Academic Handbook 2023, clause 23.4, vide paper read as 1st, it is stipulated that a separate minimum of 40% marks in both theory and practical examinations is essential for passing a course and in clause 28.2, vide paper read 2nd, it is also stipulated that a student who had failed or not secured the separate minimum of 40% either in theory or practical examination in a particular course shall register it as a re-examination course along with juniors. However the marks obtained by the student for the regular practical class work, records and assignments from the first attempt will be retained.

The evaluation pattern for Undergraduate Programmes (UG) have been changed in the context of the implementation of the recommendations of Sixth Deans Committee from 2024 admission onwards and fixation of total marks for each course at 100. In view of this, a proposal for revising minimum required mark for a pass in theory, practical and progressive assessment is placed before the Special Academic council held on 20/08/2025 as detailed below as per the reference read 3^{r d} paper above
